



2008 SIBOR Education Scholarship Fund Scholarship Application

Purpose

Through its scholarship program, the Staten Island Board of Realtors (SIBOR) Education Scholarship Fund works to raise the level of knowledge, professionalism and client service among those in the real estate profession by encouraging participation in advanced real estate designation and certification courses.

Eligibility

Any SIBOR member who has at least one year experience in real estate sales and/or other related discipline, and is licensed and practicing in New York State is eligible.

Application

- ___ Applications must be postmarked by December 31st of each year.
- ___ Two letters of recommendation supporting the applicant must also be postmarked by December 31st. Recommendations should include one from a broker or manager of the firm with which the applicant is associated; the other from someone else familiar with the applicant professionally (such as a local board officer, a community or civic organization leader or other professional).
- ___ Applicant must attach a letter providing information about why this particular scholarship is desired, plans for use of the scholarship, how it will assist in career development, and future goals relating to the use of the scholarship. A statement of community involvement, local board activities and any other information that might aid in the selection process should be included in the letter.

Awarding of Scholarships

Applications will be reviewed and awards announced by SIBOR at the Top Producer Lunch (March) of each year.

2008 Awards are available toward the fee for completed courses up to a maximum of \$200.00.
Courses **must be completed** by February 28, 2009.
